

#### VITICULTURE

Located in the Waihopai Valley, free draining river gravels with mixed silt loam over a clay base.

23 year old vines, clone 10/5 conventional rows and plant spacing, extensive vine management ensures expressive, concentrated fruit.

#### WINEMAKING

Selectively hand harvested, warmed immediately and fermented for around 10 days, before a post ferment maceration on skins for 15 days.

Rested in 300L Hogshead barrels for 11 months, with 30% new oak.

#### VINTAGE CONDITIONS

A cool frosty start to spring led to a low flowering season. This meant the vines were naturally low cropping, thus the usual viticulture regime of fruit thinning was greatly diminished. This combined with a hot Indian Summer, with very little rainfall, led to the grapes having an open cluster architecture with small, concentrated, even berry size. All reds ripened very quickly earlier on average in the season, so it became a race to get fruit off the vine to ensure the flavour would be perfect. The fruit was perfectly clean, an Utopian harvest.

#### NOSE

Red, aromatic fruit aromas - blueberry and plum meld alongside violets, cinnamon and nutmeg, with aniseed influence.

#### PALATE

Seamless structure, with layers of wild berry fruits and spice framed with subtle French oak. A perfect balance between intensity, elegance and refinement.
